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## 1.0 Competitor Entry Fees and Registrations:

Countries should arrive on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2011 (or before) for accreditation and final payments of the following fees:

-  Competitor entry fee: US\$ 150.00
-  Team entry fee: US\$ 100.00 per team
-  Pre-arranged Sparring: US\$ 50.00 per team

### 1.1 The entry fee includes:

-  Championship ID card subject to accommodation being booked via Event Organisers,
-  Free entrance to the Stadium,
-  Transport from Wellington Airport, Bus or Train terminal to hotel accommodation. Transportation to the TSB Bank Arena is easy walking distance from hotels,
-  Medical assistance during competition days (for competitors)

**Please Note:** Registrations must be done through the “Registration” website, with the user name and password to be sent to all the Federation representatives of each country.

### 1.2 Visas:

New Zealand has visa free immigration for most ITF Member Federations.

The organising committee will contact each country to discuss any Visa requirements. However Team Managers or Competitors should check directly with NZ Immigration on any visa criteria that may apply to you. Those with foreign passports other than of their country representation should pay particular notice on any Visa requirements.

In case of any problems please contact the Organising Committee.



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## 2.0 Hotel Accommodation:

Participants will be accommodated in quality hotels.

The packages are per person sharing a twin room and include **breakfast** and **dinner** (without beverage) and ID card.

For single rooms please contact the Tournament Organiser at [Travel@ITFNewZealand2011.com](mailto:Travel@ITFNewZealand2011.com). Additional costs will apply provided that single rooms are available.

The Hotel services begin on the day of arrival with dinner and finishes with breakfast on the day of departure.

Every participant must book the Hotel through the Organizing Committee. A fee of US\$100,00 (per person) to obtain the ID Card will be incurred by those who do not follow this procedure.

## 2.1 Accommodation Notes:

### 2.1.1 Accommodation Reservations:

The Hotel Accommodation reservations must be done from the “Registration” website. A user name and password sent to all the Federation representatives of each country.

### 2.1.2 Arrival Dates:

For those arriving –

-  before Sunday 6th March 2011 or
-  depart after Monday 14th March 2011 or
-  do not make the accommodation reservations before 15th January 2011

Team Managers must contact the Organising Committee for availability and new prices no later than 60 days before the Championships.

### 2.1.3 Accommodation Deposit:

To secure accommodation a deposit of 20% is required to be paid by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2011. Payment instructions and details will be sent to Team Managers shortly via their allocated Country Liaison Manager by the organisers.

### 3.0 Competition Rules:

#### 3.1 General Information:

The competition will be competed according to the ITF Competition Rules as defined at [http://www.tkd-itf.org/pub\\_web/ver\\_eng/comp\\_rules.html](http://www.tkd-itf.org/pub_web/ver_eng/comp_rules.html)

At all times, competitors, coaches and officials must wear their ID cards while on the competition floor.

Competitors will be required to report to the appropriate Ring Marshall responsible for each ring. They will co-ordinate and escort the competitor to and from the ring.

Only those competitors (and seconds) actually competing at the time will be allowed on the competition floor.

Junior competitors are born in the years from **1993** to **1997**.

**Competitors born in 1993 may compete as either a Junior or Senior competitor**, but must decide the class category at the moment of registration. He/she shall then compete in Individual and team matches according the decided Junior or Senior class.

#### 3.2 Other Information:

##### 3.2.1 Special Techniques

It has been approved last year (and tried out in the World Cup 2008) that the long flying side kick will be changed into the **high flying side kick**.

##### 3.2.2 Power Breaking

In power breaking it is permitted to **MOVE** forward, slide, skip and or jump, a forearm guarding block must be adopted before and after each attempt to break the board(s).

**The step criteria and L-Stance ready position is not required any longer.**

##### 3.2.3 Safety Equipment

All competitors must wear approved sparring gear and optional matching head gear of a **Blue** and/or **Red** colour for free sparring competition.



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### 3.2.4 Team Pattern - Performance

Teams (five (5) competitors) will perform as follows:








-  Team Red Optional Pattern
-  Team Blue Optional Pattern
-  Team Red Designated Pattern
-  Team Blue Designated Pattern






The designated Pattern and optional Pattern being any from CHON-JI to GE-BAEK.

### 3.2.5 Pre-Arranged Free Sparring

Two (2) participants follow a prepared scenario that enables them to skilfully exhibit a wide variety of techniques without fear of injury.





They shall participate according the following rules and regulations:

-  Pre-arranged free sparring must consist of Traditional Taekwon-Do movements as shown in the ITF Encyclopedia, Manuals CD Rom and as taught in the International Instructor Courses.
-  Attacking techniques must be a blocked or avoided and must be performed with realism
-  Competitors may be from 1st to 6th degree and may be Male, Female and/or Mixed Couples
-  Duration of one (1) round: minimum 60 seconds – maximum 75 seconds
-  Competitors shall enter the ring, bow, assume an L-stance guarding block and at the command of Si-Jak by the centre referee the bout time will start.
-  The bout time ends with a final blow and when one competitor shouts goman indicating the end of the bout assuming an L-stance guarding block.
-  Teams that exceed the 75 seconds bout duration will receive 0 points

-  NO protection gear may be worn.
-  Only one acrobatic sequence per competitor may be performed during the bout.
-  Teams performing more than one acrobatic sequence technique during the bout shall receive deduction of points
-  Teams shall compete according to the pyramid system.
-  In the event of a tie teams will compete once more until the places are decided.

#### 4.0 Coaches Information:

Coaches must wear appropriate Team Apparel with running shoes while coaching at all time.

-  Only one (1) coach of a country is allowed to enter the coaching zone.
-  Only a coach can present an official protest as defined by ITF competition rules.
-  Not more than two (2) coaches per country will have access to the draw
-  Coaches meeting will be on **Monday 7th March 2011 at 18.00.**



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## 5.0 Umpire Information:

### 5.1 General Country Requirements:

The Event Organiser shall cover the hotel accommodation and meals to a maximum of 4 x Umpires per country according to the following requirements:

1. Countries participating from 0 to 4 competitors may bring one (1) Umpire (no obligation)
2. Countries participating from 5 to 15 competitors must bring **one (1) Umpire**
3. Countries participating with more than 15 competitors must bring **two (2) Umpires**

### 5.2 Important / Additional Requirements:

- 👊 Countries participating with 30 to 50 competitors are **allowed** to bring one additional Umpire for a total of 3 x Umpires.
- 👊 Countries participating with more than 50 competitors are allowed to bring two additional Umpires with a total of 4 x Umpires.
- 👊 The hosting country may participate with approval of the Umpire Committee with more than four 4 x Umpires.
- 👊 Extra Umpires shall pay for their own accommodation and meals.
- 👊 Countries that do NOT bring an Umpire shall pay a fine of US \$ 1000 for each missing Umpire according to bullet point 1 or 2. These amounts shall be used for the development of Tournament & Umpire Committee.
- 👊 Countries who are NOT in possession of an Umpire may request an Umpire from a different country in order to avoid the fine.
- 👊 Umpires that fill their job for the entire event shall receive a daily honorarium amount for each competition day.
- 👊 Umpires must be in possession of the "A" class qualification.




### 5.3 Umpires Accommodation:

Umpires will be accommodated in a twin shared accommodation. The Umpire hotel has excellent rooms and facilities and is at the Organisers expense for a 7 days / 6 nights hotel (Tuesday to Monday) stay. The accommodation includes a full board arrangement (breakfast, lunch and dinner) to a minimum of 65 and maximum of 75 Umpires

**Note:** Umpire check-in is on Tuesday 8th March 2011 and check-out is on Monday 14th March 2011

### 5.4 Umpire Options:

Those umpires wishing:

-  A **single** room or
-  Arrive before Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2011 or
-  Depart after Monday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2011

### 5.5 Umpires Workshop / Meeting:

Umpires must attend the umpire workshop / meeting on **Tuesday, 8th March 2011 from 15.00 to 18.30 hrs** dressed appropriately as per the ITF Umpire rules.

Umpires who fail to attend the umpire workshop / meeting shall be removed from the umpire list and will be required to pay their own expenses.

## 6.0 Other Important Information:

-  **On-line Registrations:** Will open on the **30<sup>th</sup> October 2011** for Competitors, Coaches and Officials. On-line registration will close on **10th February 2011**
-  **Draw:** The draw for competition shall take place on **15<sup>th</sup> February 2010** and will be sent by e-mail on **1<sup>st</sup> March 2010** to the Country's Team Manager or Head Coach. They are able to check and download all the draws as they are not given out at the Venue. In case of an unexpected event the draw(s) may be adjusted.
-  **ID Cards:** At all times, competitors, coaches and officials must wear their ID cards while on the competition floor.
-  **Expenses:** Each country will be responsible for their own expenses whilst attending the World Championship.
-  **Injuries and Travel Insurance:** The Organizing Committee will not be responsible for any injuries. All participants must arrange full Travel Insurance coverage and must ensure that accidental injuries occurring at the Tournament are covered under this policy.
-  **National Anthem and Country Flag:** Each country must bring their national flag 2 x 1 m. Also a full length national anthem and one version restricted to 45 seconds that will be used during the medal ceremonies.
